Report on the audit of the Standalone Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying standalone quarterly financial results of Kansal Fibres Limited (the company) for the quarter ended 31st March, 2021 and the year to date results for the period from 1st April, 2020 to 31st March, 2021, attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").

Basis for Opinion
